1	Arrival	The action or process of arriving
2	Departure	The action or process of leaving especially for a journey.
3	Commute	Make the same journey regularly between work and home
4	A round trip	You go on a journey and return to where you started from
5	Ferry	Boat or a ship for taking passengers and vehicles across an area of water
6	Excursion	A short journey or trip especially taken as a leisure activity
7	Pilgrimage	A journey to a holy place undertaken for religious reasons
8	Pilgrim	Person who goes on a journey to a holy place for religious reasons
9	Dome shaped	A hemispherical roof, e.g. on a palace or cathedral
10	Motel	A roadside hotel typically having rooms arranged in low blocks
11	Refectory	A dining hall, especially in a monastery, convent or college
12	Sightseeing	The activity of visiting places of interest in a particular location
13	Holy pond	A pond that is attached to a religious place that is considered holy
14	Self-catering holiday	If you go on a self-catering holiday you take an accommodation where you have to cook your meals
15	Holy dip	To take a dip in holy water
16	Subway	A tunnel under a road used for pedestrians
17	City dweller	A person who lives in the city
18	Voyage	A long journey involving travel by sea or in space
19	Picturesque	A scene so picture perfect that you double check to make sure its real
20	Hitch-hike	Travel by getting free lifts in passing vehicles
21	Ambience	Atmosphere and character of a place
22	Yacht	A medium sized sailing boat equipped for cruising or sailing
23	Queue	Stand in a line
24	Explore	Travel through (an unfamiliar area) in order to learn about it
25	Exotic	Of foreign origin or character
26	Expedition	A journey undertaken by a group of people for a particular purpose
27	Rapids	Fast moving water
28	Recreation	Activity done for enjoyment when one is not working
29	Woods	Forests
30	Port	A town or city with a aharbour
31	Harbour	A place on the coast where ships take shelter
32	Snowcapped	A covering of snow on a mountain peak
33	Getaway	An escape or a quick departure
34	Inn	A pub typically one in a country
35	Sojourn	A short stay at a place
36	Lodge	A small house at the gates of a park or in grounds of a a large house
37	Embark	Go on board a ship or an aircraft
38	Paradise	Heaven
39	Downtime	Time during which a machine, especially a computer is out of action or unavailable for use
40	Campground	American term for campsite
