2	Advisory	For the purpose of giving advice
3	Stepping stone	A stage or step that helps achieve a goal
4	Cautionary	Warning someone that they should be careful
5	Stumbling block	Something that stands in the way of achieving a goal
6	Consultative	Providing advice or help on a particular subject
7	Erroneous	Incorrect
8	Expert	Expert help or advice is given by someone who has a lot of skill or knowledge
9	Shake off	To get away from a pursuer
10	Glimmer	A slight suggestion or vague understanding

12	Proffer	Hold out or put forward to someone for acceptance
13	Unanimous	Agreed by everyone
14	Proposal	A suggestion especially a written or formal put forward for consideration by others
15	Backing	Active approval often in financial form given to a person, organization or cause
16	Recommendation	A suggestion to the best course of action put forward by an authoritative body
17	Equilibrium	Sense of being able to maintain bodily balance
18	Indication	A sign or piece of information that indicates something
19	Gratification	A feeling of pleasure of satisfaction
20	Admonish	To caution, advice
21	Gratitude	A feeling of being thankful to somebody for doing something
22	Referral	An act of referring someone or something for consultation
23	Catalyst	Something that makes a change happen
24	Monition	A formal notice to a person not to do something specified
25	Solace	Comfort at a time of sadness, grief or disappointment
26	Intimation	An indication or hint
27	Console	To provide comfort to somebody who is distressed or disappointed
28	Hint	A slight or indirect indication or suggestion
29	Beneficent	Doing good or charitable acts
30	Beneficiary	Someone who receives a benefit from something
31	Rely on	Depend on
32	Deterrent	Making people decide not to do something by making them realize that something unpleasant could happen to them
